




# Landscape scholarships

## art. 1 – Aims

Fondazione Benetton Studi Ricerche, within the framework of research activities on landscape and the care for places developed with its Scientific Committee, establishes on a yearly basis **landscape study scholarships** respectively named after Sven-Ingvar Andersson (1927-2007), Rosario Assunto (1915-1994) and Ippolito Pizzetti (1926-2007), key figures for the Foundation's scientific work since its inception. The legacy of their tutelage continues to inspire and guide landscape studies and research and that is why the scholarships focus on three thematic areas that represent their cultural profile and field of activity:

- **Landscape project**  
(Sven-Ingvar Andersson)
- **Theories and policies for landscape**  
(Rosario Assunto)
- **Nature and gardens** (Ippolito Pizzetti)

## art. 2 – 2021/2022 edition

The seventh edition 2021/2022 will grant **two six-month scholarships** in the thematic areas of “landscape project” and “nature and gardens” respectively.  
For the first area, candidates are invited to

submit a research project which focuses on **landscape and energy** and explores the different scenarios prompted by today's energy policies, starting by compiling a series of up-to-date references which include a collection of virtuous case studies around the Mediterranean.

For the second area, candidates must submit a research project on the subject of the **care and enhancement of historical gardens** in Italy. Here, it must also be based on critical analysis of studies, research and experimentation currently ongoing in Italy. Candidates may individually submit one research project only and are asked to pay close attention to the instructions in article 4 below; candidates are encouraged to submit entries with innovative content that reflects the scientific work of the Foundation.

## art. 3 – Duration, amount, period of performance

The duration of the scholarship, residential and non extendable, is six months each. The value of the scholarships is set at Euro 10,000.00 (gross).  
The scholarship will take place from 15 January 2022 to 15 July 2022.

#### **art. 4 – Application and selection of participants**

The scholarships are open to Italian and foreign graduates (master's degree/laurea magistrale) and postgraduates, under the age of 40 on 31 August 2021.

Research grant holders, or those who hold a public or private position, and carry out any work activity on an ongoing basis cannot apply. Candidates will be selected based on their application.

The application form is available with the call at [www.fbsr.it](http://www.fbsr.it) or at the Foundation secretary's office (via Cornarotta 7, Treviso, open from Monday to Friday, 9:00am-1:00pm, 2:00pm-6:00pm).

**Applications** must include the following documents drawn up in Italian language (except the graduation thesis and original scientific papers if English is the original language):

- description of the scientific project put forth by the applicant, highlighting the thematic area of the scholarship one applies for (with reference to article 2), the title and content of the research, its aims, the time frames and methods for carrying it out (maximum length 4,000 characters including spaces);
- European layout curriculum vitae, indicating the languages spoken (good knowledge of Italian, both written and spoken is required);
- summary biographical note, written in a discursive form, which includes the most important information relating to the training and the scientific and professional profile of the candidate (maximum length 2,000 characters including spaces);
- copy of the degree thesis and any scientific papers (including master's or doctoral/PhD thesis);
- a signed and dated presentation letter of a professor and/or scholar the candidate has collaborated with;
- copy of applicant's identity card, tax code and residency permit (if applicable).

The application with the various attachments must be sent by email to [paesaggio@fbsr.it](mailto:paesaggio@fbsr.it) with subject line "Borse di studio sul paesaggio 2021/2022".

In any case the documents shall be sent solely in computer form, word or PDF file.

Their overall weight, if sent by email, shall not exceed 10 MB, otherwise it is kindly required to use WeTransfer.

**The deadline for submitting the applications is set without exception to the 31st of August 2021, at 12 am.**

The **selection of scholarship holders** shall be unappealable and shall be made by a commission specially set up by the Foundation, whose members come from its structure and its Scientific Committee. The Commission reserves the right to summon applicants for an interview.

**The results shall be disclosed within Friday 29 October 2021** by publication on the website [www.fbsr.it](http://www.fbsr.it) and subsequently notified by e-mail to the successful candidates.

Within **15 November 2021** the successful candidates shall send to the Foundation secretary's office a declaration of acceptance of the scholarship, and shall thereafter sign the contract and internal regulation. Otherwise, the commission could identify, among the submitted applications, other candidates for assigning the scholarships.

#### **art. 5 – Scholarship procedures**

Each scholarship holder shall have a scientific advisor appointed by the Foundation's Scientific Committee, while all staff shall be available to guide the fellows in their relationships with the facility, also with reference to the scheduled activities during their stay.

The Foundation undertakes to highlight and disseminate the scientific results of the research carried out through the methods it deems most appropriate.

The scholarship holders' place of work shall be at Fondazione Benetton, with the possibility of leaving the premises subject to agreement with the internal advisors according to the research programme. Fondazione shall provide the fellows with the necessary spaces and services (including secretary's office, library, map library and archive).

Board and any accommodation in Treviso shall be borne by the scholarship holder. The Foundation's secretary's office is available to provide information and clarifications also regarding accommodation possibilities in Treviso.

The Foundation reserves the right to amend the methods and topics of the scholarship in relation to any internal needs.
